SYNOPSIS

The fourth edition exceeded expectations in terms of participation and goal. 120 runners ran the relay of 170 KMs. In their last stretch of 10K up to the finishing point, they were joined by 94 runners from Anantapur 10K, a category introduced in this edition.

It saw the participation of athletes from countries like India, Spain, Australia, Ireland and the USA. With an increase in female runners, the challenge aims to be a platform to promote gender equality while bringing change among communities in need.
